Rules of the "Roadworks in OSM"

1 The competition was organized by the Association of Polish OpenStreetMap. Contact organizers can be obtained by writing to the address <a href="mailto:zarzad@openstreetmap.pl">zarzad@openstreetmap.pl</a>

2 The aim of the competition is to promote the design and enhancement of the OpenStreetMap project data mileage of national, provincial, and others in Poland.

3 The competition runs from 1 May 2013 to 30 June 2013

4 The task is to introduce the OpenStreetMap database <u>chainage</u>, The bars distance markers.

Assumptions:

- The participant selects a place on the road (highway, ekpresowej, national or provincial), which is marked with post pikietażowy n mi + 0 by placing the node with the appropriate tagging
- a properly tagged shall be:
  - highway = milestone (tag indicating the post pikietażowy)
  - pk = <km> (tag indicating the distance from the beginning of the route, the value read from the post)
  - ref = <phone drogi> tag indicating the number of the road (eg, ref = A1)
- node should be placed in the axis of the road, but without adhering it to the road and other objects
- interpolating permitted, but only a maximum of three consecutive points (Km). The participant who will not be able to prove that the data entered were collected "in the field", may lose the right to the prize.
- 5 It is expected the following prizes:
  - for first place a material prize worth about 400 zł

- for second place a material prize worth about 250 zł
- for third place a material prize worth about 100 zł.

First place excludes the participant the opportunity to receive awards in the following editions of this competition (if there will be).

6 The emergence of winners, possible disqualification and professional supervision is carried out in the Organizer by the Competition Commission.

The person to whom the data quality will be raised doubts and no proof of the adequately be excluded from the competition. In case of doubt the origin and quality of the organizer reserves the right to delay the awards, and in extreme For up to remove the questionable data from the OSM database.

10th Participant agrees not to release data from other maps such such as Google Maps, Targeo, Zumi, etc., and other licensed incompatible with reflective. Competition in your assumption is based on data collected in the field or from the Participant's own knowledge of the area. 11th Members of the Competition Commission may take part in the competition laws Participant and their right to receive any prizes for participation the competition is disabled.

12th The decision of the Jury, you can appeal to the organizer - the Board OpenStreetMap Polish Association.

13th The organizer reserves the right to make changes to these regulations, as Also in the algorithm of counting points. Announcements of changes will be published on the site OpenStreetMap project forum.

14th The right to a binding and final interpretation of the provisions of the Regulations shall have Organizer

15th The organizer is not responsible for any problems resulting from the action osm.org database.

16th Participate in the competition may be a person who has completed 13 years.

17th Participation in the competition is equivalent to the expression by participants consent to processing by the organizer of their personal data for the purposes of the Competition Act (Data Protection dn.29.08.1997 the Journal Poz.833 No. 133, as amended.)
