TRIGNET WORKSHOPS: FEBRUARY AND MAY 2009

1. During the past few months a number of changes have been made to TrigNet including the introduction of a real time service in the Durban/ Pietermaritzburg area, densification of the Gauteng real time service, more single base real time stations and updated co-ordinates among other things. With all these changes it is inevitable that users will be uncertain about how to go about using these services effectively. This has become apparent through the increased number of queries we have been receiving.
2. In order to address these queries and at the same time to learn from the experiences of our clients, the Chief Directorate: Surveys and Mapping will be holding three workshops; one in Cape Town on the 17th of March 2009, one in Bloemfontein on the 19th of March 2009 and a third in East London on the 7th of May 2009. The Bloemfontein and East London workshops are scheduled to be held on the day prior to the SAGI Branch AGMs of these two regions. The venues for the workshops are as follows:
